**Duties & Responsibilities:** Under limited supervision, serves as an instructor for public safety training in Impaired Driving & Speed Detection Training topics. Participates in needs assessment, research, design and evaluation of statewide public safety training programs. Position also serves as the Statewide Coordinator for the SFST training programs.

**Minimum Requirements:** Eighteen months of work experience as a general instructor in various law enforcement topics with specialized instruction in traffic law and traffic enforcement, specifically in the area of alcohol/drug impaired driving and speed detection (RADAR & LIDAR).

**Special Qualifications:**

1. Must have excellent writing and research skills
2. Must have the ability to teach complex topics in a clear, concise and easily understandable manner.
3. Advanced computer skills.
4. Ability to research and develop lesson plans.
5. Must possess exemplary skill and knowledge in law enforcement topics.
6. Ability to work nights, weekends, and holidays.

**Required Certifications:** Must currently possess a Georgia P.O.S.T. General Instructor certification in good standing. In addition, the qualified applicant will also be a N.H.T.S.A. certified SFST Instructor and/or an I.A.C.P. certified DRE Instructor. These certifications must be current and in good standing. Must be able to obtain a P.O.S.T. Specialized Instructor certification in Speed Detection (RADAR & LIDAR) within twelve months of employment.

**Other Remarks:** This announcement is open to anyone meeting the minimum requirements.

Selected candidate subject to criminal records background and drug screening clearance.
