Who Should Attend: The course is directed to senior fire executives (battalion chief rank or higher). This is consistent with other Executive Skills Series (ESS) courses and the resident Executive Fire Officer Program (EFOP). The curriculum acknowledges the diversity of fire service organizations (paid, volunteer, combination) and therefore is applicable to all fire/emergency services organizations.

Course Description: In this 2-day course, students will be introduced to a four-step model for managing change effectively. These activities include analysis, planning, implementation, and evaluation. The same model will be used to examine the executive role of leading change. A variety of activities and simulations will apply theories to contemporary issues that executive officers experience daily. This course is for senior fire officers of both career and volunteer fire/emergency services organizations.
