JOB DESCRIPTION:

Open to all qualified applicants.

Under general supervision, performs inspections, preventive maintenance, and repairs of electric/electronic power systems and associated machinery, and physical structures and equipment, such as plumbing fixtures, refrigeration units; heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) and electrical devices at GPSTC facility. Responsible for supervision of state inmate workers and other staff.

<u>Essential Functions</u> require the ability to lift, push, pull, and carry heavy items. Prolonged standing, stooping, and walking is required. Must not object to working off ladders. Must not have fear of heights, climbing, wearing safety equipment or working in close places.

MINIMUM OUALIFICATIONS:

Two years experience in building repairs and maintenance. Knowledge of the methods of maintenance and repair of skill and technical areas such as electricity, carpentry, HVAC, plumbing and the use of relevant trade tools, equipment, and materials.
