Participates in needs assessment, research, design and evaluation of statewide public safety training programs. Demonstrates teamwork and high degree of customer service.

- Ability to teach, lecture and conduct practical exercises in a safe, clear, concise and easily understandable manner.

- Ability to obtain position specific instructor certifications within timeframe.
- Application of exemplary skill and knowledge in law enforcement topics.
- Strong interpersonal communication skills.

Minimum Training & Experience:

Eighteen months of work experience as an instructor providing training development and delivery in various law enforcement related topics. Possession of Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Basic Law Enforcement certification.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference may be given to those applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum training & experience requirements, possess one or more of the following:

- Specialization in an advanced subject area applicable to the basic LE mandate training.
- Possession of Georgia POST General Instructor certification.
- Possession of Georgia POST specialty instructor certification(s) in area of position assignment, i.e., Driver Training Instructor, Firearms Instructor, etc.
- Possession of specialty certifications in area of position assignment, i.e. Crime Scene Technician, RADAR/LIDAR, etc.
