**Description of Duties & Responsibilities:** Under limited supervision, serves as an instructor for public safety instructor training in advanced or specialized topics, including but not limited to, criminal investigation techniques, crime scene response, electronic surveillance, and related courses. Participates in needs assessment, research, design and evaluation of statewide public safety training programs. Demonstrates teamwork and high degree of customer service.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Thirty-six months of work experience as an instructor in peace officer topics which included aspects of criminal investigation techniques, crime scene response and practical crime scene investigation, drug enforcement investigatory techniques; clandestine laboratory investigations; and gang investigations.

- Ten years of work experience in law enforcement of which five years specializing in drug enforcement investigations.

- Specialization in an advanced subject area applicable to drug enforcement investigatory techniques, clandestine laboratory investigations, and gang investigations.
- Possession of Georgia P.O.S.T. General Instructor certification.
- Possession of specialty certifications and/or substantial training background in drug enforcement investigatory techniques, clandestine laboratory investigations, gang investigations, electronic surveillance techniques, etc.
