Public Safety Trainer III, Basic Law Enforcement, Forsyth Academy

JOB DESCRIPTION:

Under limited supervision, conducts classroom-based lecture and practical skills building sessions for Basic Mandate Law Enforcement training delivered throughout the year at a GPSTC regional academies. Participates in needs assessment, research, design, and evaluation of states public safety training programs.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

Instructor of topics include firearms, defensive tactics, and driver training for law enforcement along with Crisis Intervention Training for Cadets and Agencies throughout the region. There are long periods of standing, riding, driving, bending, and squatting required. Year-round training in all weather conditions. Wearing of personal protective equipment, i.e. RedMan Training suit used for defensive tactics training.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

If you have already obtained a Defensive Tactics Instructor Certification, no additional requirements. If you have not obtained the Defensive Tactics Instructor Certification prior to interviewing, you must schedule time with an academy Sr. Manager or designate to observe you doing:

1. 25 push-ups in 60 seconds or less
2. 30 sit-ups in 60 seconds or less
3. 1.5 mile run in 16 minutes or less

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Eighteen months of work experience as an instructor providing training in various law enforcement related topics. Possession of Georgia Peace Officer Certification in good standings and General Instructor Certification.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

Preference may be given to those applicants who possess one or more of the following: have a minimum four years recent law enforcement work experience; have been regularly instructing in a law enforcement training program; have specialization in an advanced subject area applicable to basic LE mandate training; possess Georgia POST General Instructor Certification and any of the position required Georgia POST Specialty Instructor Certifications: Driver Instructor, Defensive Tactics Instructor, Firearms Instructor. Experience working with behavioral health, NAMI and other advocates and law enforcement. Has actively served on a CIT Response Team and/or has completed the Georgia CIT Coursework.

PROBATION PERIOD:

Employee is required to successfully obtain their required certifications within 24 months of hire (Includes: EVOC Driver Instructor, Defensive Tactics Instructor, Firearms Instructor, First Aid/CPR Instructor or at risk of disciplinary action up to and including termination.)

Other Remarks:

Selected candidate subject to a 7-year clean criminal record background check and negative drug screening results.
