**Description of Duties & Responsibilities:** Under the limited supervision of the Fire Academy Director, supervises and instructs in the courses conducted by the Emergency Communications Section of the Georgia Fire Academy Division. Duties and responsibilities include, but are not limited to,

- Supervising professional staff in the development, review, and revision of the assigned training programs as well as the administrative operations and special projects for the section; and,
- Maintaining all necessary accreditation for assigned training programs while ensuring compliance with internal and external training standards and requirements for statewide training programs; and,
- Assisting in the administration of the assigned budget items.

<u>Essential Functions</u> of this position may require long periods of standing, bending, and squatting required. Year-round training in all weather conditions.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Minimum 3 years progressive experience with an emergency response or emergency communications agency with at least 1 year experience completing duties at a supervisor level with personnel and budgetary responsibilities. Be in possession of an associate degree, or currently matriculating to that end, from an institution of higher learning accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education.

**Special Qualifications:** Must have excellent writing, research, and computer skills. Must be able to perform research in a variety of mediums and develop lesson plans. Must possess strong interpersonal communication skills and have the ability to teach complex topics in a clear, concise and easily understandable manner.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Preference may be given to those applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum training & experience requirements, possess one or more of the following:

- ICS-300: Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents
- Experience supervising a cadre of instructors.
- Experience supervising a training facility and related equipment/facilities.
- Experience in the planning and development of training programs that have specified goals and objectives and/or state mandates for training.
- Certification as a Georgia P.O.S.T. Communications Officer.
- Certification as a Georgia P.O.S.T. General Instructor.

**Required Certifications:** Must currently hold, or be able to obtain within three months, certifications as a Georgia P.O.S.T. General Instructor and as a Georgia P.O.S.T. Communications Officer. <u>Note:</u> Training required to obtain necessary Georgia certifications will be provided to selected candidate not currently possessing.
