Description of Duties & Responsibilities: Under limited supervision, maintains, diagnoses, and performs repairs of moderate difficulty on gasoline and powered engines, vehicles and other motorized equipment. Tests, Inspects, and evaluates vehicles and equipment for proper and safe operation upon completion of repairs. Submits completed work to supervisor for review and release. Responsible for the supervision of the work of inmate workers.

<u>Functional Requirements:</u> Primary functions require sufficient physical ability and mobility to work in a mechanic shop environment; walk, stand, and sit for prolonged periods of time; frequently stoop, bend kneel, crouch, reach, and twist; push, pull, lift, and/or carry moderate to heavy amounts of weights; operate assigned equipment and vehicles; crawl, climb, and to verbally communicate to exchange information.

Minimum Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED and valid Driver's License. Vocational diploma in Automotive Technology, or related field OR two (2) years experience performing vehicle mechanical duties, such as engine tune-ups and brake repairs OR three (3) years experience performing vehicle mechanical duties. Working knowledge of the mechanics internal combustion engines, transmissions, drive trains, brake systems, ignition systems, and/or electric wiring diagnostics and repair and how to utilize tools and equipment.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference may be given to those applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum training and experience requirements,

- possesses certifications and/or advanced training in utilizing diagnostic equipment/software
- Valid Class B CDL
