Description of Duties & Responsibilities: Under limited supervision, serves as an instructor for public safety training in various topics to include officer resilience. Participates in needs assessment, research, design, and evaluation of statewide public safety training programs. Demonstrates teamwork and a high degree of customer service.

Position Requirements: Excellent communication, presentation, and interpersonal skills. Strong organizational and time-management abilities. Proficient in adult learning principles and instructional design. Knowledge of various management styles and theories. Skill in using Microsoft Office Suite, Google Workspace, and other technology. Frequent travel for off-site and overnight training to include other GPSTC locations may be required.
