JOB TITLE: **Public Safety, Trainer Supervisor (Law Enforcement Investigations/Traffic Programs)**

Description of Duties & Responsibilities: Supervises, guides, and instructs the work assignments of staff assigned to the LE Ops Section, Traffic Programs including but not limited to serving as a subject matter expert in public safety training in Impaired Driving; Speed Detection Training topics; and the Drug Recognition Program. Participates in needs assessment, research, design and evaluation of statewide public safety training programs.

Oversees the effective execution for curriculum assigned to this team. Instructs for public safety training in basic, advanced and specialized topics. Participates in needs assessment, research, design and evaluation of statewide public safety training programs. Ensures that lesson plans conform to department guidelines, legal requirements, and recognized professional standards. Demonstrates teamwork and high degree of customer service.

Minimum Qualifications: High School Diploma or GED and minimum five (5) years public safety officer experience with three (3) years as instructor. One year at supervisor or lead trainer level. Specialization in and/or possession of specialty certifications in an advanced subject area applicable to, but not limited to Drug Recognition Expert, Traffic Safety Speed Detection Instructor, and related fields. Be in good standing with Georgia P.O.S.T. and any position specific certifying agency.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference may be given to those applicants who, in addition to meeting the minimum training and experience requirements, possess one or more of the following:

- Minimum three (3) years' experience at a supervisor or lead trainer level;
- Progressive work experience to a lead investigator level serving as supervisor over subordinate investigators;
- Experience planning & development of training programs with specified goals, objectives and/or state mandate for training;
- Significant knowledge of criminal laws & procedures.

Required Certifications: Currently hold certification as a Georgia P.O.S.T. General Instructor (Level 2).

Special Qualifications:

1. Must have excellent writing and research skills.
2. Must have the ability teach complex topics in a clear, concise and easily understandable manner.
3. Advanced computer skills.
4. Ability to research and develop lesson plans.
5. Must possess exemplary skill and knowledge in law enforcement topics.
6. Ability to work nights, weekends, and holidays.
7. In state and out of state travel required.
