Description of Duties & Responsibilities: Under limited supervision, coordinates and conducts classroom-based lectures and practical skills building sessions for the Critical Response Techniques training program. Collaborates with local LE agencies, behavioral health care providers, NAMI, and other advocates. Participates in needs assessment, research, design, and evaluation of statewide training programs. Regular travel to training locations.

Position Requirements: Strong interpersonal communication skills. Regular travel. Working knowledge of PC applications such as MS Word, Excel, PowerPoint, e-mail, internet.

Minimum Qualifications: Eighteen months of work experience as an instructor providing training development and delivery in various law enforcement related topics. Law Enforcement work experience. Hold a valid Georgia Driver’s License.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference may be given to applicants who possess one or more of the following:

- Georgia POST Certification as a General or Level 2 Instructor;
- Is a current Georgia CIT instructor;
- Has actively served on a CIT response team and/or has completed Georgia CIT coursework;
- Have a minimum of four years’ recent law enforcement work experience as a certified LE officer;
